The Electoral Board of Pittsylvania County met on Wednesday, November 8, 2017, at 10:00 a.m. to canvass the vote of the November 7, 2017 election. All members of the Board were present as well as the General Registrar and Assistant Registrar. Mr. Will Pace was present representing the Republican Party and Mrs. Barbara Hancock and Mr. Ben Farmer, candidates for the Callands-Gretna Board of Supervisors, were also present.

Mrs. Gilbert called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. and introduced the Electoral Board Members, the General Registrar and the Assistant Registrar.

The Board first considered the Provisional Ballots of which there were 6. Two were disqualified for lack of signatures on envelope, one voter voted at Bachelor's Hall Precinct, but he was registered at Tunstall; one attempted to register on line, but was not registered to vote according to the SBE index. Two ballots need to be considered and the Board will continue the Provisional Count until Tuesday, November 14, 2017 at 10:00 a.m.

The Board continued with the canvass and cross-checked the numbers called in on Election Night with the actual Statement of Results from all precincts. A final count cannot be given until the Provisional Ballots are considered on November 14, 2017. All observers left at this time.

Ms. Bailess then advised the Board of an incident of potential voter fraud at precinct #207, Gretna High School. Election officials from the precinct were contacted to come in and the Board met with them individually. The two pollbook officials did not return phone calls nor did they come in to be interviewed.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:25 p.m. until Wednesday, November 24, 2017 at 10:00 a.m.
