The Electoral Board of Pittsylvania County met on March 18, 2019, at 10:00 a.m. for an organizational meeting of the Board. All Board members were present.

Mrs. Gilbert called the meeting to order and stated the purpose for our meeting. Mrs. Arthur made a motion that we keep the same officers as we had for the previous year. Mr. Terry seconded the motion, and the vote was unanimous. The form for updating the Electoral Board Information was then prepared by Ms. Bailess to be sent to the State Board of Elections.
