

# Pittsylvania County Public Safety, Deputies and Volunteers Assist with Mock Shooting Exercise





A mock road rage incident turned shooting was used Wednesday as a training exercise for students at the Pittsylvania Career and Technical Center. The students were assisted by Pittsylvania County Public Safety personnel, Pittsylvania County Sheriff's deputies, 911 dispatchers and County fire and rescue volunteers.

The exercise was planned and coordinated by EMT Instructor JoAnn Lohr and Criminal Justice Instructor Caleb Farley.

The initial call to 911 indicated a routine response to a traffic accident, but the incident quickly began to expand when a mock shooter became part of the scene.

# VDOT Proposes Three Roads for Rural Rustic Program




The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) is proposing to add three Pittsylvania County roads to the state's secondary six-year plan for unpaved roads, also known as the Rural Rustic Roads program.

The three proposed roads are Dairy View Road (Route 694, .78 miles) in Kentuck; Rockcreek Road (Route 781, 1.48 miles) in Rondo and Midway Road (Route 671, 1.52 miles) in Gretna.


### Life Lessons: The Pittsylvania-Caswell County Youth Livestock Show and Sale






Pittsylvania County's first responders answered the call to service this week, saving the lives and property of the County's citizens. EMS responders

answered 194 primary calls for service between April 11-17. Of those, volunteers responded to 140 of those calls – or 72%. Pittsylvania County Public Safety were the primary responders on 54 of those calls, or 28%, and outside agencies took one.

The County's fire departments responded to 68 fire calls during that same period.
