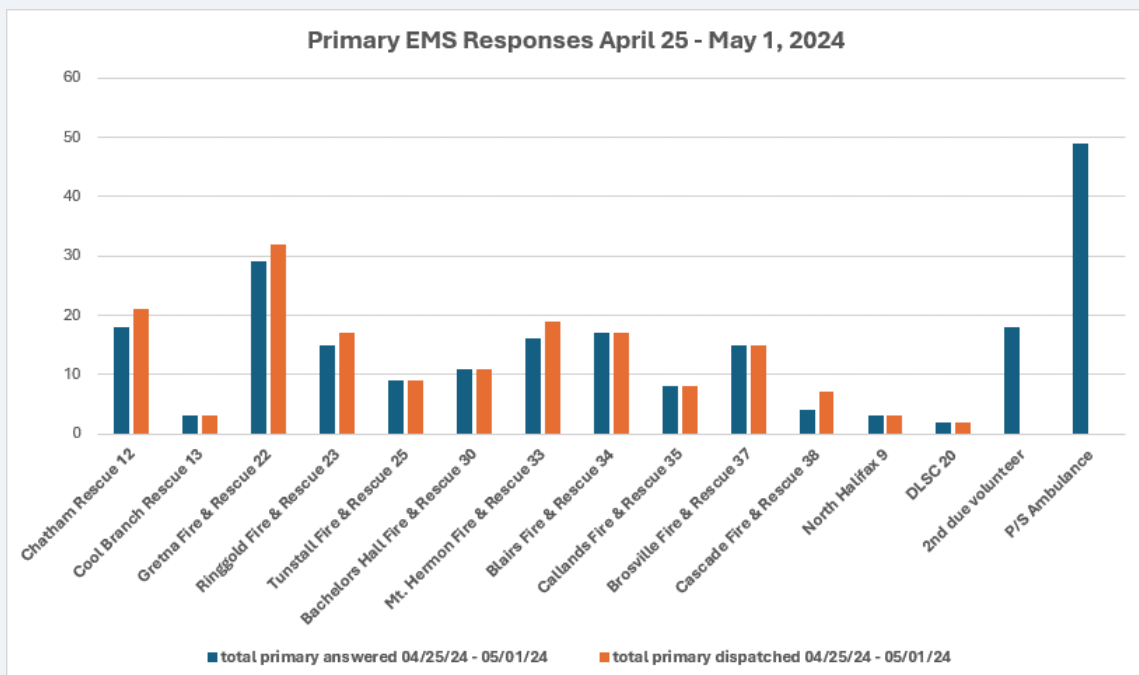
# Pittsylvania County First Responders

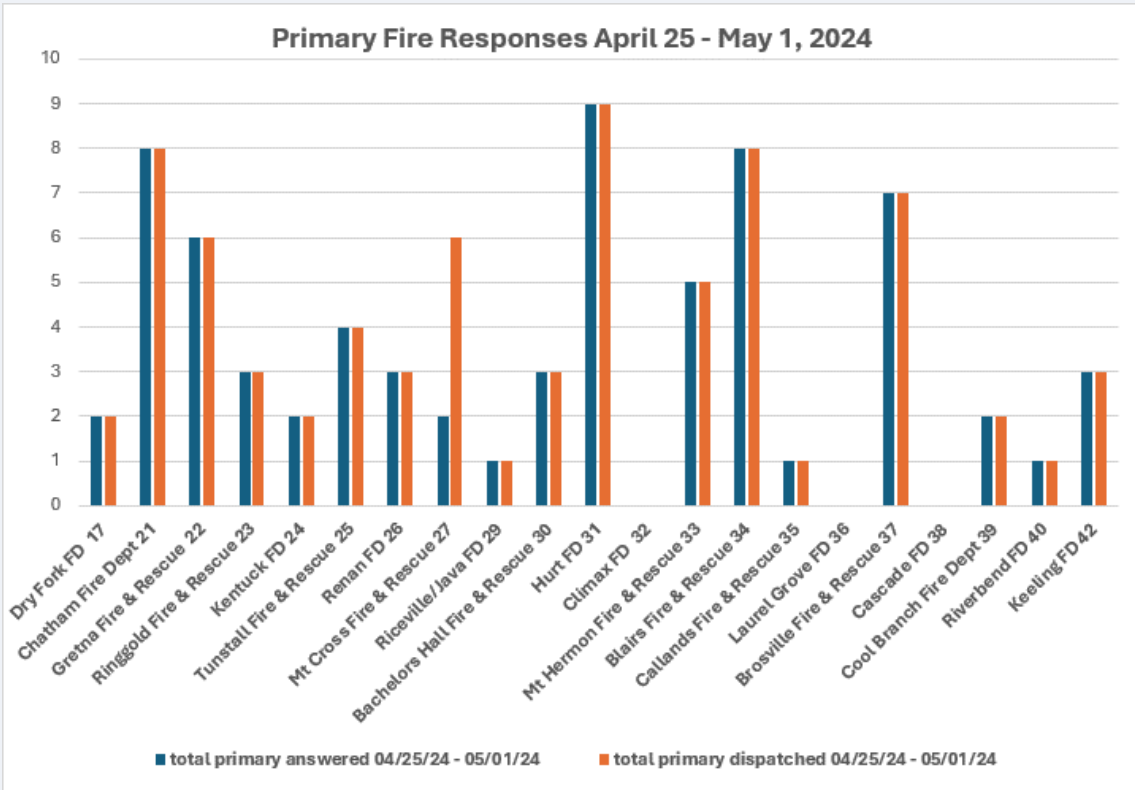
## ANSWERING THE CALL



Pittsylvania County's first responders answered the call to service this week, saving the lives and property of the County's citizens. EMS responders answered 217 primary calls for service between April 25 – May 1. Of those, volunteers responded to 168 of those calls – or 77%. Pittsylvania County Public Safety were the primary responders on 49 of those calls, or 23%, and outside agencies took four.

The County's fire departments responded to 70 fire calls during that same period.
