Data Center Rezoning to go Before Board of Supervisors



Why This Location?

- 946 Acres
- 200 MW Power with potential for significant expansion onsite
- Mid Atlantic Broadband Main Dark Fiber Trunk Line abuts Property
- 3+ MGD Water Service
- 1+ MGD Sewer Capacity
- 200 MCF/HR Natural Gas



At its June 4, 2024, meeting, the Pittsylvania County Planning Commission unanimously recommended approval of a rezoning request for a data center in the Ringgold area of Pittsylvania County. The recommendation for approval came after a duly advertised and conducted public hearing. The application, submitted by Anchorstone Advisors SOVA, LLC, will go before the Pittsylvania

County Board of Supervisors on July 16, 2024. This is the first data center application for consideration in the County.

RiverStreet Installs Final Equipment Building in Ringgold



RiverStreet Networks was at the Ringgold Fire Department on June 4 placing the last of its five service buildings as part of the county-wide high-speed fiber internet project. The other service buildings are in Strawberry, Java, Carter's Lodge and Brosville. Critical data equipment will be housed within the service buildings and together, they allow for the formation of a connected network of fiber to better serve Pittsylvania County. Pittsylvania County is partnering with RiverStreet to bring this much needed service to its citizens, and the project is expected to be completed in late 2025.

Changes to Federal Drug Box Law to Impact County Agencies



Pittsylvania County Public Safety and the County's 11 volunteer organizations that offer first responder EMS transport services are now required to establish pharmacies for use when responding to calls.

The requirement stems from the Drug Supply Chain Security Act under the U.S. Food and Drug Administration and enforcement begins November 27, 2024.

Previously, hospitals and health systems provided EMS agencies with pre-filled drug kit exchange systems as well as replenishment of used or expired drugs contained within the kits.

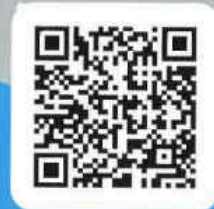

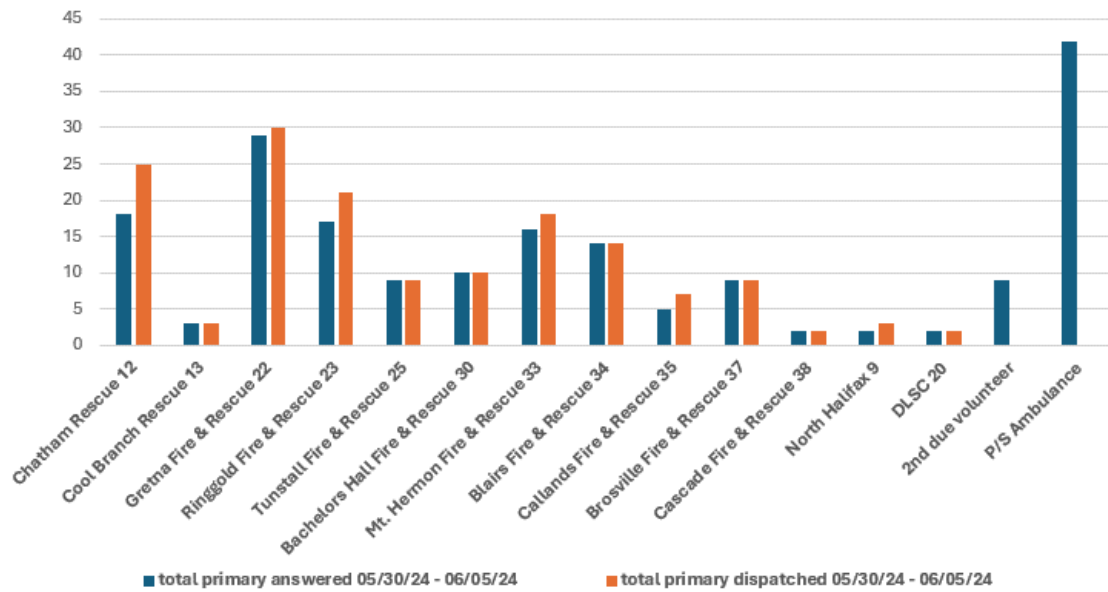

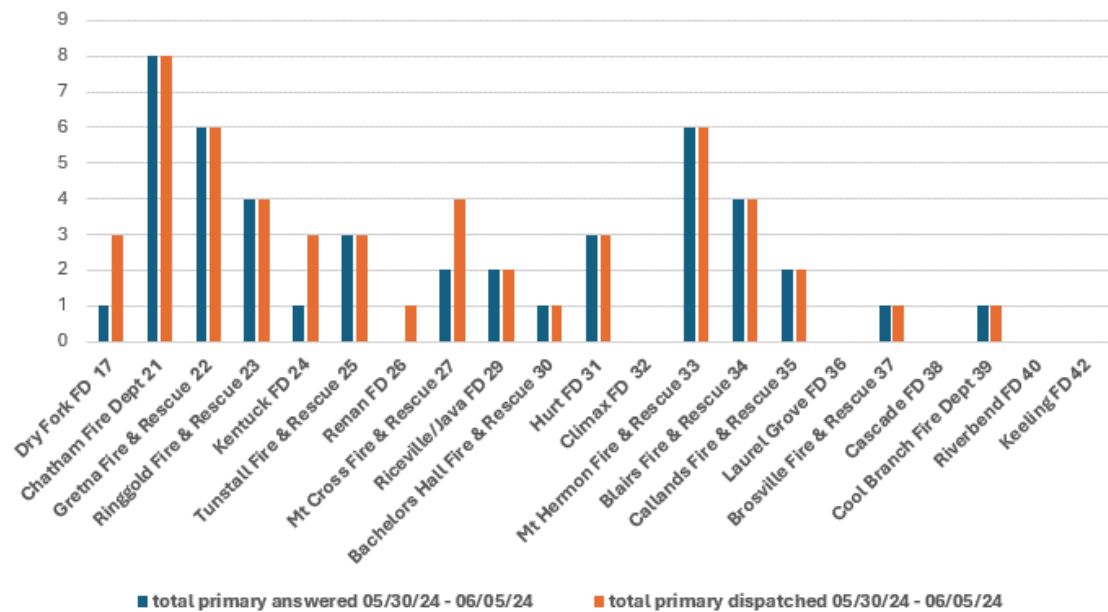
Pittsylvania County's first responders answered the call to service this week, saving the lives and property of the County's citizens. EMS responders answered 187 primary calls for service between May 30 – June 5. Of those, volunteers responded to 145 of those calls – or 78%. Pittsylvania County Public Safety were the primary responders on 42 of those calls, or 22%, and outside agencies took eight.

The County's fire departments responded to 43 fire calls during that same period.
