




Pittsylvania County's first responders answered the call to service this week, saving the lives and property of the County's citizens. EMS responders answered 115 primary calls for service between June 27-30 (Fiscal 2024 ended June 30). Of those, volunteers responded to 91 of those calls – or 79%. Pittsylvania County Public Safety were the primary responders on 24 of those calls, or 21%, and outside agencies took two.

The County's fire departments responded to 36 fire calls during that same period.





Fiscal 2024 Totals

For Fiscal 2024, Pittsylvania County rescue agencies responded to a total of 9,986 EMS calls. Firefighters responded to 3,445 fire calls for the same period, July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024.
