

His father, Calvin, was the station's first chief when it was founded in 1958. His brother, Barry, served in the department, as did his daughter, Stephanie, stepson Walter Henderson and his nephew, Joseph. All are part of the many awards and photos that grace the station walls.


Neal, 70, remembers running around the station as a toddler, driving a firetruck at 16 and becoming assistant chief and on the department's Board of Directors at 18. By 1991, and in his mid-30s, Neal was named chief.


Citizens Academy Tours 911 Center, Jail, Public Safety








Pittsylvania County's first responders answered the call to service this week, saving the lives and property of the County's citizens. EMS responders answered 201 primary calls for service between July 4-10. Of those, volunteers responded to 162 of those calls – or 81%. Pittsylvania County Public Safety were the primary responders on 39 of those calls, or 19%, and outside agencies took eight.

The County's fire departments responded to 77 fire calls during that same period.
