### **BerryDunn Presents Public Input Findings for Master Plan Update**



A sports complex, senior programs and staffing, as well as maintaining and improving existing parks, were a few of the recurring themes that surfaced during the community engagement phase of Pittsylvania County's update of the 2010 Parks and Recreation Master Plan.

The findings, compiled since the project began in November 2023, were presented to the Board of Supervisors during its July 16, 2024, work session by Berry Dunn, the consultant partnering with the County to update the 2010 Master Plan.

### Speyside Bourbon Cooperage to Bring 40 New Jobs to PittCo



RICHMOND - Governor Glenn Youngkin announced that Speyside Bourbon Cooperage, Inc. will invest \$16.85 million to build a new stave mill in Pittsylvania County's Brosville Industrial Park, the company's fourth facility in Virginia. The new stave mill will create 40 new jobs and source 40 percent of its timber needs from Virginia forest landowners. The operation will supply the company's bourbon barrel cooperage in Smyth County

**Bid Request Issued for Ringgold Rail Trail Bridge** 



The Virginia Department of Emergency Management has expanded the scope of the Ringgold Rail Trail bridge repair and Pittsylvania County has issued an invitation for bids to repair the structure.

The original grant amount of \$3,028,121 has been increased to \$5,328,210, and includes federal, state and local funding.

### VDOT Posts 45 mph Speed Limit on Barker Road




Figure 1: Study Area Map


#### Parks and Recreation: Public Input Reveals Needs, Wants in Facilities, Programs





Pittsylvania County's first responders answered the call to service this week, saving the lives and property of the County's citizens. EMS responders answered 190 primary calls for service between July 18-24. Of those, volunteers responded to 146 of those calls – or 77%. Pittsylvania County Public Safety were the primary responders on 44 of those calls, or 23%, and outside agencies took three.

The County's fire departments responded to 50 fire calls during that same period.

#### **Introducing** Virginia SUN Bucks



A federal program created to fight food insecurity by providing eligible children with a one-time \$120 food benefit on a Virginia SUN Bucks card to purchase groceries.

Who is automatically eligible for Virginia SUN Bucks and does not need to apply?

Your child is automatically enrolled in Virginia SUN Bucks if they:



Receive SNAP or TANF benefits or participate in an income-eligible Medical Assistance (MA) program.



Applied for and received free or reduced-price school meals at school during the 2023-2024 school year through the National School Lunch Program (NSLP).

How do I know if my family needs to apply for Virginia SUN Bucks?

If your child did not apply for and receive free or reduced-price school meals through the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) or your family does not participate in SNAP, TANF or an income-based Medical Assistance program, you must apply.

When and how will VDSS issue Virginia SUN Bucks benefits?

Benefits will be issued beginning August 2024 on a rolling basis to children who automatically qualify and to families who are eligible by application. SNAP recipients benefits will be loaded onto their existing SNAP EBT card. Non-SNAP recipients' will receive a SUN Bucks card that will be mailed to the address on file.

How do I apply?

Beginning July 1st, you can visit <u>VirginiaSunBucks.com</u> to print and and mail the application to 5600 Cox Road, Glen Allen, VA 23060 OR you can call the Virginia SUN Bucks contact center to apply over the phone at a later in July.
